Schedule(ish) information

This is a general outline for your information and subject to change... we may not always look like it, but we do have a plan 😊

- After we land in St. Louis the drivers will try to get a head start on the shuttle to the Budget car rental location, so we don't inundate them with 20 teenagers.
- It's about a half-hour drive from the airport to the hotel, where we should have ample time to unload and chill
- Before dinner we will travel to the primary club - Vetta Sports-Concord (5 minutes) so that players can check in for the tournament and get an introduction to the club.
- We will then have a team dinner at Dulany's Grille (9940 Kennerly Rd. (a 10–15-minute drive). Dinner is buffet style and is for parents and players and is paid for by the team.
- Each night, as early as all the coaches are back to the hotel, we'll have what we call the coaches meeting. This is where we plan out the next day (as best as possible).

Setting what time each of the kids (and parents) need to leave the hotel as well as which kids will need to transfer clubs over the course of the day. Each night after the coaches meeting, we'll do room checks and let the kids know what time their ride is leaving the hotel.

- Playing at two clubs requires some coordination, but Lisa is experienced and up to the task! Hotel to Vetta Concord (main club) is only 10 minutes, while hotel to Vetta West is 25 minutes. The two clubs are 30 minutes apart.
- Each day the kids will be expected to come down early for breakfast (included in the hotel price) and then load up in their scheduled vehicle to get to the clubs.
- Kids will be eliminated from the tourney as early as Friday possibly, but they will still be expected to come to the clubs and cheer on their teammates.
- Sunday will be very similar to Sunday at State with a trophy ceremony after the completion of finals. We will hopefully have time after the ceremony to return to the hotel for quick showers for those who played, before heading to Bandanas Bar-B-Q (less than 10 minutes) for a team dinner (everyone pays for their own meals). After dinner we'll let the kids be kids with fun team activity.
- Monday, we plan on packing up, doing room checks, and heading down to the Gateway Arch (about 20 minutes) before heading to the airport (another 20 minutes).

What to pack:
