SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

The Josh Nelson Memorial Scholarship is available to applicants who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Graduating students attending either Sprague High School or a homeschool program within the Sprague boundary, obtaining a diploma or a GED by August 1, 2024; or students residing within the Sprague boundary who obtain a GED by August 1, 2024;
- Active participants with the Sprague Racquetball Team;
- Participants who have played in at least one sanctioned Oregon High School Racquetball League match during their time as a member of the Sprague Racquetball Team; and
- During the scholarship period, any applicant who is awarded a scholarship must be enrolled in a full-time program, as prescribed by the college, university, junior college, vocational/technical school, or other eligible educational institution in which the applicant is enrolled.

APPLICANTS WHO ARE NOT CURRENTLY ON THE SPRAGUE RACQUETBALL TEAM ARE **NOT** ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP GRANT.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications are due **FEBRUARY 23, 2024**. Late applications will not be accepted.

APPLICATION MATERIALS CHECKLIST

- A completed application, with four essay answers (Attached, Items #1-4 and #6-7, and verification/signature page);
- Two letters of recommendation (Item #5);
- A high school transcript, GED diploma, or homeschooling testing results (10th-grade requirement) (Item #6); and
- A Coach Input Sheet (CIS). **NOTE:** *The Committee and coaches organize completing each applicant's CIS; **applicants do not need to submit forms to a coach.*** (Item #8).

INSTRUCTIONS

Completed applications, with attachments as described in this Scholarship Application packet, must be submitted via email, in PDF format, to the Josh Nelson Memorial Scholarship Committee, at Scholarship@SpragueRball.com. The submission may be one combined PDF file or multiple PDF files. Letters of reference may be submitted by the applicant or by the person writing the letter.

It is important to follow the directions in this Scholarship Application packet. **Please complete the application form in full**; incomplete applications will not be considered. (**Example:** If you use an attachment to complete an item, write "See Attachment" on the form and then correctly label the attachment with your name and the appropriate item number, and follow the same format used in the Application.) **Do not leave any item blank.**

The Josh Nelson Memorial Scholarship Committee was established by the Racquetball Development Group (RDG) (FEIN 82-4845162), which created the scholarship fund and awards scholarship grants. The Committee can be contacted at Scholarship@SpragueRball.com.

The Committee’s Guiding Principle is to evaluate applications in light of the qualities that most represent Josh Nelson, who was a Sprague Racquetball team member during the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons. An applicant must exemplify leadership, teamwork, effort, dedication, and commitment to community -- in the context of racquetball, life outside racquetball, or both. An applicant also must demonstrate upstanding character and academic pride. The Committee agrees that the listed qualities can take many forms and that an applicant may use any examples that the applicant thinks is appropriate.

The Committee reserves the right to make decisions and make recommendations to the RDG about scholarship grants, based on the clarity and completeness of the applications received. The Committee also reserves the right to use its best judgment to make final recommendations, concerning the final candidates, based on the goals, intent, and purpose of the Josh Nelson Memorial Scholarship.

Because of the potential volume of applications, the Committee cannot respond to inquiries regarding the status of specific applications.
